Dear George:

Next week the House will consider legislation to impose partial sanctions on South Africa. That legislation is a further step in the right direction. But I believe that the rapidly worsening situation for the Black majority population in South Africa requires that we pass a bill with full sanctions and disinvestment.

Accordingly, when the legislation comes to the Floor, I will offer H.R. 997 as an amendment in the nature of a substitute. I hope that you and the others who voted for this measure last year will actively participate in the debate.

If the amendment in the nature of a substitute fails, I will offer a series of strengthening amendments.

I look forward to your support and participation.
