Thanks very much for your courageous sponsorship and efforts on behalf of Senate Resolution 386, the "Mandela Freedom Resolution," which passed the Senate yesterday.

Senate approval of this Resolution, following House passage of our identical Resolution on September 18th, firmly places the Congress of the United States on record in solidarity with prisoners of conscience in South Africa and in opposition to the apartheid regime's persistent and flagrant violations of the black majority's civil, political and human rights.
