Dear George:


With your invaluable help two weeks ago, the House of Representatives, in passing H.R. 1460 (the Anti-Apartheid Act of 1985), seized an historic opportunity to redirect American policy toward the apartheid regime of South Africa.

The overwhelmingly bipartisan vote of 295 to 127 indicated that the American people are anxious to see that our foreign policy toward South Africa become consistent with our national values and interests.

Now we must await Senate action. However, I am both confident and encouraged that, with your continued support, meaningful sanctions legislation will be enacted in the very near future.

I want to express my warmest appreciation for all of your efforts on behalf of passage of H.R. 1460. I look forward to working closely with you again as we move toward final action on this critically important legislation.
