Dear George:

This has been a very productive legislative session in the South Carolina General Assembly with regard to South Africa. Enclosed is a copy of the Concurrent Resolution denouncing apartheid which was passed by the General Assembly. In addition, I have enclosed copies of three bills which passed the Senate and have been referred to the House for action. I was especially gratified that S.727, which calls for complete divestiture of South Carolina's economic involvement in South Africa, survived by a vote of 26-1 on a motion to carry over, and by one dissenting vote on final passage.

While we in South Carolina have not achieved a clear-cut victory, I think the stance taken by the Senate signals the mood of the State on the racist system of apartheid. It is unlikely that the House will take action on these bills before adjournment, but the fight will resume next session. I will keep you informed of future developments.

20 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the
21 State of South Carolina:

23 SECTION 1 The 1976 Code is amended by adding:
24 "Section 34-1-130. Every financial institu-
25 tion shall file with the Board annually a
26 statement indicating the nature and extent of
27 its financial or banking activities commenced or
28 instituted after the effective date of this act,
29 other than normal correspondent requirements,
30 with the government of the Republic of South
31 Africa, national corporations of the Republic of
32 South Africa, or agencies or instrumentalities
33 thereof. The statement must be in the form and
34 contain information as the Board shall
35 prescribe."


Thanks very much for your recent correspondence on the anti-apartheid legislation that has been introduced and passed by both the General Assembly and the Senate of the State of South Carolina.
