Although I'm not one of your constituents and my opinion thus doesn't count at election time, I want to applaud you on your courageous stance in favor of legalization of drugs.

You should also know that, outside of Congress, there are battallions of citizens who look to legalization as the only sensible solution, and who are actively working to that end. Indeed, there are several legislative models of legalization schemes already drafted and in circulation.
