
"I am proud to be an original co-sponsor of the Right to Clean Vehicles Act, which is intended to immediately grant California's waiver, as well as provide the authority for a growing number of additional states seeking to regulate greenhouse gas emissions from motor vehicles.

There is simply no excuse for the Bush administration to deny California's waiver, or any other state's effort to combat global warming and promote the use of cleaner, more efficient vehicles on their roads.
