
Dear Mark:

Here is the "Free Nelson Mandela" badge that you requested.

I am also sending you a copy of my resolution, H. Res. 373, which I hope you will agree to co-sponsor. The resolution calls on President Reagan to publicly endorse Secretary Shultz' admonition to South Africa to free Mandela and to recognize the African National Congress as a legitimate representative of South Africa's Black majority.

It also represents the thinking of Chief Mangosuthu Buthelezi, who was reported in the June 3rd edition of The Washington Times as having said "emphatically that he will not take part in talks unless Mandela is released and the ANC is recognized as a negotiating entity."
