Dear Congressman Crockett:

Thank you for your letter of July 23 concerning South African divestiture.

On March 11, 1983, the Board of Governors of Wayne State University unanimously adopted a statute directing University officers to divest of all stocks, bonds, or real property in companies which operate in the Republic of South Africa and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics. There also is a Michigan statute, Act. No. 512 of the Public Acts of 1982, sponsored by Representative Perry Bullard, which requires such divestiture by all of Michigan's public colleges and universities.
