Dear Coleman:


John and I are moving ahead on plans to publicize the state's foot-dragging on the issue of pension fund investments in companies doing business in South Africa. We hope to work in close cooperation with the members of the Michigan Legislature who are also working on this matter, and, of course, we know we can count on your support.

I recommend for your reading the article on Michigan funds in South Africa which appears in the March edition of the newspaper Michigan Voice. It has been helpful to us in our plans. The article, however, makes a reference to Detroit which we find confusing. It says City officials refused to provide information on the amount of investments the City has in companies doing business in South Africa. If this is so, I would appreciate knowing the reason for the City position.
