Dear Congressman Rose:

This is in response to your May 28, 1985, letter re:
AT&T's business activity in South Africa.

- AT&T has no facilities, investments, or employees in South Africa.
- Distributors in South Africa sell terminal equipment manufactured by AT&T's subsidiary, The Teletype Corporation.
- Olivetti, of which AT&T is a 25 percent owner, has a subsidiary in South Africa. Olivetti is authorized to sell AT&T telecommunications and computer equipment in South Africa. As part of our distribution agreement, Olivetti has subscribed to The Sullivan Principles.
- AT&T Technologies, Inc., purchases palladium and platinum from South Africa for use in the manufacture of telecommunications equipment.
